26/15	Minutes of the meeting held on 7 th April 2015 were approved and signed as a complete record.
27/15	<p><u>Matters arising</u></p> <p><u>Resident's Parking</u> An article has appeared in the Newsletter highlighting the problem of inconsiderate parking. A problem was highlighted on Main Street where car parking is blocking the view of vehicles leaving the Post Office. Resolved – contact PCSO</p> <p><u>Road sign on north St Catherine's Drive</u> This has been inspected but there was confusion about which sign was damaged. Resolved – to clarify to ERYC which sign.</p> <p><u>Traffic Problems at Leconfield School</u> Cllr Metcalfe-Thompson reported that the road markings have been repainted.</p> <p><u>Litter Picking Group</u> ERYC had offered equipment to borrow if the group sorts out a date. The resident concerned would like to write an article for the newsletter and use the Parish Council email address to get any responses. Resolved – to agree to the above and let the resident know.</p> <p><u>Newsletter Main Street</u> Delivery of this area had been sorted.</p> <p><u>Pot holes</u> These had all been reported.</p> <p><u>Derelict property Arram</u> The Clerk had received some information from ERYC, but Cllr Welbourn was not present. Resolved – discuss at the next meeting.</p> <p><u>Noticeboards</u> Resolved – to do a walkabout and assess the condition of the individual boards.</p>

28/15	<p><u>Planning Applications</u> <u>Applications received</u> Erection of dwelling on land north of 1a Carnaby Close. There had concerns expressed from local residents about access and parking issues. The development was not on the local development plan and there were still concerns about sewage and water issues in the village. Resolved – after a discussion it was agreed to respond with (d) the Parish Council recommend that the application be refused and referred to Committee, giving the reasons above.</p>
29/15	<p><u>East Riding of Yorkshire Council Matters</u></p> <p><u>Election</u> The election would be uncontested in Leconfield as the number of nominations was less than the places available. There had been some confusion with Cllr Scruton’s nomination. Resolved – to check with Electoral Services to make sure Cllr Scruton has been elected and get more detail about the return of the expenses forms.</p> <p><u>Surface Dressing</u> ERYC would be surface dressing Castle Close, Old Road, St Catherine’s Drive and Wyndham Close from the beginning of May. It could take up to 21 weeks to complete with the work they have to do in other areas.</p> <p><u>Planning Liaison Meetings</u> There would be a meeting at Beverley on 15/06/15 to discuss the new electronic system for planning responses and other planning issues. Resolved – to see if anyone is available.</p> <p><u>Anti-Social Behaviour Statistics</u> There had been 2 incidences of interventions to tackle ASB in Leconfield between October and March.</p> <p><u>St John of Beverley Service</u> This was due to be held on Sunday 10/05/15. The Chair couldn’t attend and asked if anyone was interested in going. Resolved – to see if anyone was free.</p>
30/15	<p><u>Correspondence Received</u></p> <p><u>Playground</u> A resident had emailed to inform the Parish Council that she had found broken glass on the playground. Resolved – to check the area after the meeting.</p> <p><u>ERNLLCA Training</u> Sessions were being offered on “Being a Good Councillor”, the nearest ones being in Driffield or Pocklington.</p>

	<p>Minor Injury Unit Campaign NHS East Riding of Yorkshire are trying to publicise the Minor Injury Unit at Beverley Hospital and had sent some information.</p> <p>Grant Application Leconfield Pre-School have written asking for a grant towards some new equipment. Resolved – to award £150 to the group.</p>
