15/17	<p><b><u>Minutes of the meeting</u></b> held on 6<sup>th</sup> February 2017 were agreed and signed as a complete record.</p>
16/17	<p><b><u>Matters arising</u></b></p> <p><b>Stones on road</b> – bend near barracks has been swept and there has been an accident but this was not connected with the surface. The Main Street/Old Road junction has been swept but still has stones. <b>Resolved</b> – to report to ERYC.</p> <p><b>Affordable housing survey</b> Mr Siddle is pulling together the survey results and will report back next month.</p> <p><b>PC Vacancies</b> ERYC have confirmed that the PC may now co-opt. <b>Resolved</b> – Cllr Healy agreed to put an article in the newsletter.</p> <p><b>Change of Signatory on PC account</b> This has been confirmed.</p> <p><b>Village Hall Heating</b> Binks coming on 15<sup>th</sup> March. Liaised with Village Hall Committee so that the Hall will be free and a key will be obtained.</p> <p><b>Bus stop</b> EYMS have responded that it is the responsibility of ERYC. <b>Resolved</b> – to chase up with ERYC.</p> <p><b>Damage to the raised area on The Poplars</b> <b>Resolved</b> – to report again.</p> <p><b>Footballing resident enquiry</b> The young resident who was asking for goalposts had contacted the Village Hall committee but has not had a response as yet. <b>Resolved</b> – to chase up with Village Hall committee.</p> <p><b>Closure Arram Level Crossing</b> The letter that had been sent out about the closure had stated that</p>

Cllr Welbourn had queried this and it had been incorrect and would be changed.</p> <p><b>Playground Equipment Inspection</b> Cllr Leng had not been able to check what was needed to update the equipment. <b>Resolved</b> – to discuss next month.</p> <p><b>Newsletter</b> No objections on bi-monthly newsletter so far <b>Resolved</b> – to continue to consult and discuss next month.</p> <p><b>Flood Defences</b> Following concerns about the company who built the defences going bust, ERYC had confirmed that they had now completed the work. There was a discussion about what appears to be water flowing off the field on Miles Lane. Near 30mph signs coming in from Cherry Burton. Not finding it's way into the gullies and into the flood alleviation system. <b>Resolved</b> – Cllr Pollard agreed to report to ERYC.</p>
