## Minutes of the Meeting held on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2018

69/18	<b>Minutes of the meeting</b> held on 1 <sup>st</sup> October 2018 were agreed and signed as a complete record.
70/18	<p><b>Matters Arising</b></p> <p><b>Footpath adjacent to Churchyard</b> Some contact details had been found at Diocese Office. Cllr Huzzard had discussed the path with the contractors who had been digging a trench recently. They had been given permission by ERYC to do the work but the condition of the footpath after they had finished still needs attention. <b>Resolved</b> – to contact ERYC to contact the contractor.</p> <p><b>Leconfield School</b> ERYC had responded about the issues raised last month. The school had done a survey of the pupils and parents and a number of the responses had expressed concern about the level of lighting. <b>Resolved</b> – the School will contact ERYC directly and mention surveys. Also School and PC will contact ERY Cllr Pollard to let her know about the situation.</p> <p><b>Pedestrian gate to Playing Field</b> The Play Inspection Company had been contacted but were unable to give to advise about the replacement gate. <b>Resolved</b> – to wait until the next inspection which is due early 2019 and try and get some information then.</p> <p><b>Car Park markings</b> An estimate had been received but was thought to be rather high. <b>Resolved</b> – to get further estimates.</p> <p><b>Sportsfield/Miles lane hedge work</b> The resident had responded that she was happy that her concerns had been addressed. Cllr Huzzard has been liaising with the contractors and planning the work.</p> <p><b>Neighbourhood Watch</b> The meeting with the representative is still to be arranged.</p> <p><b>Broken Septic tank lid</b> The company who made the tank have ceased trading, but enquiries are still being made by the Recreation Club representatives.</p>

	<p><b>Utility covers</b> The covers at 2 The Poplars and 4 Ashtree Drive are both wobbling. <b>Resolved</b> – to chase up again with ERYC. <b>Cracked BT cover on St Catherine’s Drive</b> This had now got a cone on it. <b>Resolved</b> – to chase up again with ERYC.</p>												
71/18	<p><b><u>Planning Applications</u></b> Erection 4 dwellings Lissett Close (amended plans) The Parish Council’s previous comments had been noted.</p>												
72/18	<p><b><u>ERYC matters</u></b> Rough Sleeper Survey This is taking place in the early hours of Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2018. <b>Resolved</b> – to report any sitings to the Clerk who can forward them to ERYC.</p>												
73/18	<p><b><u>Correspondence Received</u></b> Anti Social Behaviour Statistics</p> <p>Email re tree damage near flood defences. A resident had emailed expressing concern about some trees that appear to have been damaged. Cllr Huzzard has been an inspected the area and met some contractors from Landplan. They have been asked to thin out the nearby copse and had left some of their branches. The fence has also been replaced. Gates have been installed further down and locked which would prevent walkers walking on the flood alleviation land. Resolved – to discuss on walkabout with representatives of ERYC and respond to resident who complained.</p>

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75/18	<p><b><u>Any Other Business</u></b></p> <p>Cllr Huzzard – ERYC have not extended the turning circle next to barrier beside Telephone Exchange. The use of this has increased with the new bus stop. Resolved – to contact ERYC and find out why.</p> <p>Cllr Huzzard had also attended the information meeting about the Hornsea Project Four Offshore Wind Farm. The cable may be crossing Miles Lane and may result in traffic calming issues. The work may not take place for another five years.</p>												

	<p>Cllr Brean had attended the meeting with the Police and Crime Commissioner and fed back. The new Commissioner wanted to liaise with Parish Councils if there were any relevant issues he could help with.</p> <p>Cllr Welbourn – barriers around the drain near the station and pot holes in Arram still need attention.  <b>Resolved</b> – report again.</p> <p>A resident expressed concern about the amount of vegetation in the dykes North Drain onwards, Cllr Huzzard to send plan.  <b>Resolved</b> – to contact ERYC.</p> <p>Old Road –  Footpath on Old Road opposite bridge water pools on road and will ice up in the winter. Also chase up other issue raised in September about water pooling on path.</p>
