**TELL US WHAT YOU THINK!**

Following a challenging year for everyone we are hoping that restrictions will be lifted soon, which will enable us all to start meeting up again and getting back to some normality in our lives.

Everyone's view is important and we want to hear your views on the villages you live in, whether that is Leconfield, Arram or Scarborough.

Whilst restrictions are still in place which prevent us meeting face to face, we are planning to start our engagement process using virtual meetings. Youth Leaders in the village are also engaging with 9-25 year olds during April/May, through a questionnaire, to find out their views on what there is to do in the village (including clubs), whether they feel safe, their use of the village hall, speed of the internet and green space.

The virtual focus groups will be conducted using Zoom, in sessions lasting 60-90 minutes and will be chaired so that everyone on the group has the opportunity to tell us what they think. The sessions will not provide answers to your concerns - they are taking place to gain your views which will be captured during the sessions. We will be holding the focus groups on a Monday evening commencing at 7:00pm.
